SPPS is a unique short reports journal in social and personality psychology. Articles should not exceed 5,000 words (excluding references) and may present new theory, new data, new methods, or any combination of these. Preferences will be given to articles that

- have theoretical and practical significance
- represent an advance to social psychological or personality science
- will be of broad interest both within and outside of social and personality psychology
- are written to be intelligible to a wide range of readers including science writers for the popular press
